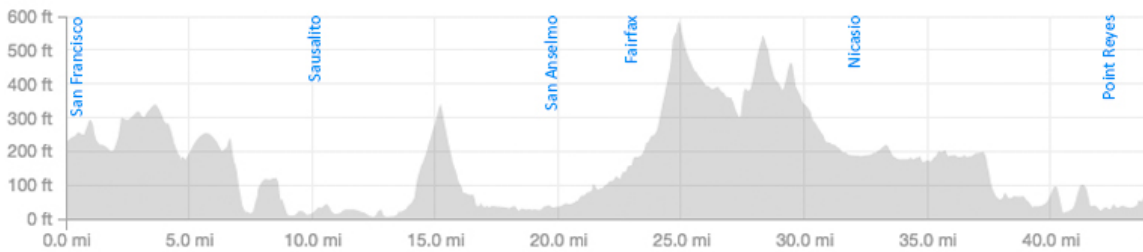
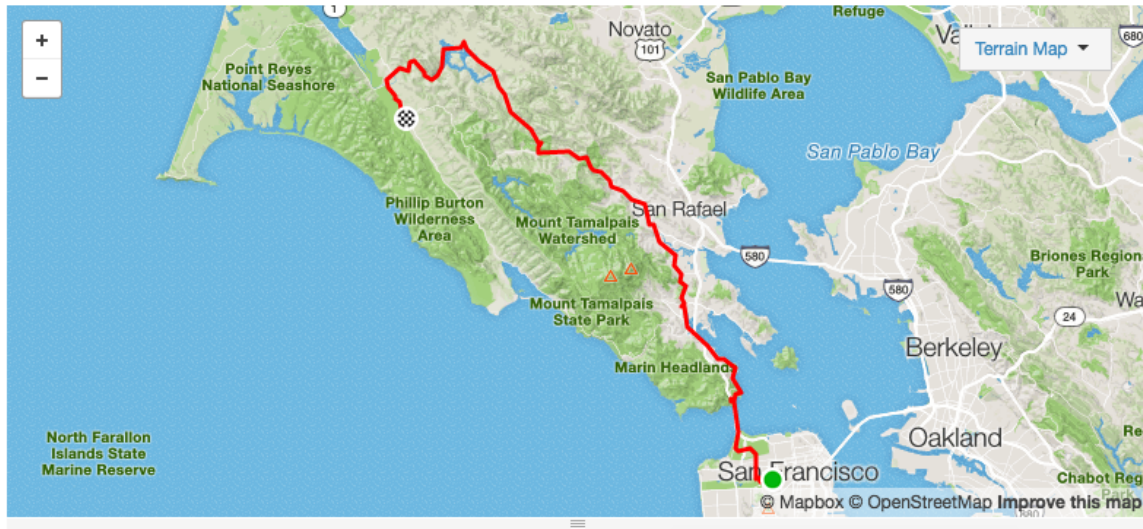




Day 1 - San Francisco to Olema Campground 46 miles

Leaving San Francisco this morning, head through the small North Bay towns of Sausalito, Ross, San Anselmo, and Fairfax. Shortly before lunch, take a turn towards the Petaluma hills, and enjoy miles of rolling farmland and rural countryside. Lunch will be pond-side at a local cheese factory before continuing through Marin County, and reaching camp just south of Point Reyes Station.





Day 2 – Olema Campground to San Francisco 39 miles

From Olema, you'll cruise along HWY 1 to Stinson Beach, where you can choose to have a snack on the beach. From there, the last major climb of the trip takes you up the side of Mt. Tamalpais, into the Marin Headlands and Sausalito, before crossing the iconic Golden Gate Bridge into San Francisco.
